installation

- Insert mounting bracket bolts (A) into the back of the chair and tighten.
- 2. Loosen retaining bracket (B) on vertical post.
- Loosen knob (C) on mounting bracket and slide vertical assembly post (D) into mounting bracket. Tighten knob (C).
- 4. Position retaining bracket (B) flush against mounting bracket and tighten.
- Loosen 3 Allen screws (E) on triangular rotating bracket, insert horizontal assembly post (F) and tighten Allen screws.



Height

Raise/lower vertical assembly pole to desired position.

Depth

Loosen 3 Allen screws (E) on triangular rotating bracket and push/pull headrest to desired position. For additional depth adjustability, mount the vertical assembly pole with the curve either facing inward or outward.

Angle

Loosen 3 Allen screws (G) on circular bracket on headrest and tilt headrest to desired angle. Additional angle adjustability can be achieved by loosening the 3 Allen screws (E) on the triangular rotating bracket and tilting headrest from laterally.
